## Staying in Germany for your career?

If you are an international student or recent graduate you might struggle with some important issues:

- How do I get into the German labor market?
- Do I have to watch out for specific requirements on my application papers?
- Do I really have to send more than 100 applications to get a job?



## What is this about?

We offer you a guiding process to fetch your dream job in Germany. From an HR perspective we support you in your career planning and search effectively for your ideal job. 1-to-1 meetings will help you compose your qualities and expertise in words. We discuss job ads to figure out what type of candidate is wanted. You will exercise to present yourself and answer questions like "Why should we hire you?"



## Start and duration

The next groups in 2015 / 2016 are scheduled for:

- Nov / Dec
- Feb / Mar
- Apr / May

Only 12 students can take part in each group. Over a duration of 8 weeks there will be 1-2 meetings per week.

(The time can be fixed individually according to one's schedule.)



## Contents

- **The German Labour Market:**  
We provide you with an overview over the current demand for skilled job opportunities, earning potentials, career planning and career entry.
- **Job search:**  
Together we search and discuss job advertisements and train you to become more effective and efficient in the job-search yourself. We create targeted speculative applications, and inform you about expectations of German employers.
- **Self-marketing strategies:**  
We help you to create your personal profile, to sort out realistic career perspectives, to undergo assessment centers successfully and we train you in interview techniques (face-to-face, telephone).
- **Support in application process:**  
We give examples when to apply with application papers in German and when with those in English. Furthermore we assist you in writing your cover letters in German.



## Who can participate?

1. Recent graduates and students who are about to graduate from the **University of Paderborn**, with **permanent residence in the area of Paderborn**.
2. Students of one of the following: **Maschinenbau, Technik, Elektrotechnik, Informationstechnik or Naturwissenschaften**.
3. You will **end your studies within the next 3-6 months**.
